Supplies to have for class each day:

- *two dry erase markers *a pencil eraser *Post-It note pad(s)
- *dry-marker eraser (clean, old socks work fine for this)
- *two ballpoint pens for formal essays (black or blue) *scissors
- *two graphite pencils (standard wood or mechanical)
- *Two red, green, purple, or informal color pens or pencils for correcting
- ***Loose-leaf** filler paper (8.5 by 11 inches- NOT torn from a spiral notebook, please!)
- *A one-to-1.5 inch three-ring binder to organize papers and Cornell Notes. (If you have a larger binder- just use tabbed dividers and share it for more than one teacher.)
- *A sturdy two-pocket folder to keep assignments and smaller pages neat
- *Two differently-colored highlighters *Crayons or colored pencils
- *a good dictionary for home (Collegiate level dictionaries are the best)

Three paperback novels will be loaned to students through the year: *The Giver* by Lois Lowry, *The Hobbit* by J.R. Tolkien, and *The Outsiders* by S. E. Hinton. Each student will need to take care of the books that he or she is issued or reimburse the school for damage. A one-gallon zip-lock bag would be helpful. (Backpacks are not immune to water bottle spills.)
