Black History Month: How many of you have heard of the inventor, Philip B. Downing? I am sure you have used his work many times in your life. In 1891, anyone interested in mailing a letter would have to make the long trip to the post office. Philip B. Downing designed a metal box with four legs which he patented on October 27, 1891. He called his device a street letterbox and it is the predecessor of today's mailbox. One year earlier, Downing patented an electrical switch for railroads that allowed railroad workers to supply or shut off power to trains at appropriate times. Based on this design, innovators would later create electrical switches such as light switches used in the home.
